FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harbhajan Singh, Police Station, Division No.7 Ludhiana submits that the offences under Section 307 IPC as well as Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act have since been deleted during investigations and instead of the same offence under Section 326 IPC has been added and that at the time of compromise the case was under the provisions of Sections 326, 324, 148 and 149 IPC.

Report dated 12.02.2016 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Tarandeep Singh, Amanparteek Singh @ Babu, Gurpreet Singh @ Rikki, Sahil Sood as well as complainants Darshan Singh and Parwinder Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view the statement made by the learned

State counsel on instructions from ASI Harbhajan Singh, Police Station Division No.7 Ludhiana and the fact that both the groups are rival students and that this compromise will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and to bring about harmony between the parties and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.163 dated 19.08.2015 under Sections 307,336,324,148,149 IPC and Sections 25,27,54,59 of Arms Act (later on offence under Section 326 IPC added and other offences under Sections 307,336 IPC and 25 Arms Act deleted) Police Station, Division No.7 District Ludhiana and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
