The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.119, dated 22.10.2013, registered under Sections 15/61/85 of the NDPS Act, and Sections 467, 468, 471 of the IPC, at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka.

28.07.2016 passed in CRM-M No.18181 of 2016 in respect of the co-accused Gurmeet Singh. The said order is to the following effect :-

“This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.119 dated 22.10.2013 registered under Sections 15/61/85 of NDPS Act and Sections 467/468/471 IPC at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has now been in custody since 22.10.2013.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Jalandhar Singh states that only 8 witness remain to be examined and in case the petitioner does not obstruct the trial the prosecution will lead its entire evidence on or before 27.10.2016 and till such time the bail should not be granted to the petitioner.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, in view of the undertaking given by the learned Deputy Advocate General, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence on or before 27.10.2016 (subject to the petitioner not obstructing the same) the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.”

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has also been in custody since 22.10.2013 and the above mentioned co-accused Gurmeet Singh has been released on bail on 27.10.2016 by the trial Court.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to take
