The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking permission to appear in the examinations of B.A. IInd year.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Vide order dated 27.10.2016, this court had granted bail to the petitioner with the condition not to entered Kurukshetra town till the completion of the trial. This is a petition for relaxation of that condition for only two dates i.e. 29.11.2016 and 17.12.2016, since the petitioner wants to appear for examination on these two dates.

Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly states that on 24.11.2016 the petitioner has unauthorizedly enter the limits of Kurukshetra for appearing in examination in violation of order dated 27.10.2016 passed by this court. In that view of the matter the petitioner ought not to have violated order of this Court.

Be that as it may. The petitioner is allowed to appear for examination on 29.11.2016 and 17.12.2016 by entering the limits of Kurukshetra Town, subject to deposit of fine of ₹5,000/- with this Court since he has violated the order of this Court.

In view of the above, the petition stands allowed accordingly.
