It is claimed that the petitioners have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have approached this Court for protection of their life and liberty.

The petitioners have not been able to appear in the Court on the last date of hearing also.

They have submitted a representation, Annexure P4, dated 18.11.2016, to the Commissioner of Police, District Patiala.

The matter appears to be covered by the judgment in case Pardeep Kumar Singh Vs.State of Haryana, 2008 (3) RCR (Crl.) 376.

Notice to the Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of the Court, notice has been accepted by Ms.H.K.Athwal, DAG, Punjab, present in the Court. Copy given.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that the Commissioner of Police, Patiala, will look into the representation Annexure P4, dated 18.11.2016, if the same has been received in his office and ensure that petitioners will not be forcibly taken in custody by any of the respondents on the allegations that petitioner No.1 has been kidnapped or abducted by petitioner No.2, unless and until petitioner no.1 makes a contrary statement. In case of any imminent threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners, it will be open to them to approach the Commissioner of Police, Patiala, for implementation of the order.
