This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.105 dated 08.07.2015, under Sections 307/120-B IPC and Sections 4/11, 4B/8 of the Cow Slaughters Act, registered at Police Station Khizrabad, District Yamuna Nagar.

On 11.01.2016, while issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the allegations levelled in the FIR are utterly vague and no specific role has been attributed to the present petitioner. Counsel would even advert to the impugned order dated 06.11.2015 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhari (Annexure P-2) in terms of which concession of pre-arrest bail was declined whereby stand of the State counsel was that custodial interrogation of the petitioner was required to know the whereabouts of co-accused.

List on 02.03.2016.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before

the Investigating Officer on 20.01.2016 and to join investigation.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting/ Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Rakesh Kumar would apprise the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation.

Under such circumstances, custodial interrogation of the petitioner would not be warranted.

Petition is allowed. Order dated 11.01.2016 passed by this Court is made absolute.
