Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Vijay Kumar @ Vijay in case FIR No.214 dated 09.10.2015 for offence punishable under Section 61 of The Punjab Excise Act, 1914 registered with Police Station Ladhowal, District Ludhiana.

It is contended that in the instant FIR registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, no recovery has been effected from the petitioner and only allegation against him is that if a raid is conducted, the petitioner can be caught along with illicit liquor.

Learned State counsel assisted by HC Pavittar Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined

the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted
vide order dated 08th of December, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
