Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of F.I.R. No.193 dated 24.09.2013 under Sections 420/467/468/471/120B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is not beneficiary and is merely a scribe and attesting witness.

On the other hand, learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 4 states that in the aforesaid FIR except one all prosecution witnesses have been examined and the case is fixed for tomorrow for remaining evidence. The trial is at advance stage.

In view of the fact that the prosecution evidence is on the verge

appropriate to interfere in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.

However, as regard the plea made by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner be granted exemption, he is at liberty to approach the trial Court by moving appropriate application seeking exemption from personal appearance. If such an application is filed within two weeks from today, the trial Court shall pass an order thereon within a week thereafter by taking into consideration the involvement of the petitioner sympathetically.
