For having been found in possession of 51 kgs of heroin, the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 08.02.2014.

A period of two years has elapsed and prosecution agency has not been able to conclude the trial.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial within a period of six months after the next date of hearing. In case, the trial is not concluded within said period, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again for grant of bail. However, in case, the adjournments are being sought on behalf of the petitioner by the defence counsel, the above said direction will not be applicable.
