Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.101 dated 17.07.2016, registered at Police Station Zira, District Ferozepur, under Sections 420, 506, 120-B IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Gambling Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that all the other co-accused have been granted the benefit of anticipatory bail by this Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balraj Singh has accepted these factual assertions.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Ordered accordingly.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating

Officer on 16.12.2016 or any other date as required to join investigation.

The Investigating Officer shall release him on bail to his satisfaction.

However, the petitioner shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
