Main Case

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondents to ensure the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members; to take stern and strict action against respondent Nos.4 to 11; to transfer the investigation in FIR No.151 dated 12.10.2014, registered under Sections 302, 148 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC') read with Section 149 IPC, at Police Station Sarhali, Distt. Tarn Taran, to an independent agency outside the District Tarn Taran.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without

adverting to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondents that the inquiry in the matter be carried out by some Gazetted Officer under the supervision of Mr. G.Nageswara Rao, Inspector General of Crime, Punjab within a period of 45 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Meanwhile, during the subsistence of the inquiry, proceedings before the trial Court shall remain stayed.
