The present application under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for placing on record affidavit of the petitioner.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and affidavit of the petitioner is taken on record.

The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members, which is stated to be in danger at the hands of respondents No.5 to 11.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr.Ankur Jain, Assistant Advocate

General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

It has been stated by the petitioner in her affidavit that till date no criminal case stands registered against her at Police Station City Sangrur. However, a case stands registered against her two sons and husband. As regards copy of the Daily Diary Report No.230 dated 16.11.2016, it is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that copy of the same had not been supplied to her by the concerned police official, but the petitioner is still being called in the police station almost daily without any reason and with a motive to harass and humiliate her.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the police that in case, the petitioner is required to be summoned for any enquiry, a notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. be given to her.
