JASPAL SINGH, J

This is a petition preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking direction and launching proceedings against Bachhiter Singh (having filed petition bearing CRM No.M-27267 of 2015) and also for recalling the orders dated August 17, 2015 passed by this Court.

At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he seeks no relief so far as recalling of order dated August 17, 2015 passed by this Court is concerned. However, the petitioners would be satisfied in case their representation (Annexure P-3) is enquired into and dealt with by the concerned Senior Superintendent of

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Police regarding which no action has been taken so far by him.

The contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that though representation dated September 01, 2015 (Annexure P-3) was moved to Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar Rural way back on 01.09.2015, but till date no action has been taken.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar Rural (Punjab) to look into the grievances unfolded in the aforesaid representation dated September 01, 2015 (Annexure P-3) and if some substance is found, take appropriate action in accordance with law with in a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
