INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner, Rajbir Singh, has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.485 dated 07.11.2016, registered at Police Station Mahendergarh, District Mahendergarh, under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been registered on the basis of written complaint given by Sh. Jitender Kumar, Branch Manager, State Bank of Patiala, Mahendergarh. There are allegations that the petitioner was posted as Head Cashier w.e.f. 2009 to 15.10.2016 in the State Bank of Patiala, Mahendergarh. One customer,

namely, Udaibhan made a complaint that he had handed over ₹3,50,000/- to the petitioner on 16.12.2015 for depositing in his account and the petitioner handed over the receipt to him, but in fact, the amount was not deposited in his account. Similarly, customer, Babu Ram, levelled allegations that the petitioner had withdrawn ₹35,00,000/- from his account on different dates. There are also similar allegations made by other customers. It is also alleged that the petitioner prepared bogus documents i.e. FDR certificates, vouchers etc.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
