By this petition the petitioner has sought directions to the official respondents to register an FIR against the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this connection the petitioner has also moved a representation dated 17.10.2016 (Annexure P-3) and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.3 – Senior Superintendent of Police,

Barnala to look into the matter and take appropriate action on his representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.3 is directed to look into the matter and in case it is found that any action is required, to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
