In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, respondent No.2, to assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and if it is found that there is danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala (respondent No.2) shall take necessary steps to protect their life and liberty.

Disposed of accordingly.
