Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail during pending trial to the petitioner in case FIR No.27 dated 25.2.2016, under Sections 147, 148, 149, 285, 395, 427, 436 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Baund Kalan, Tehsil Charkhi Dadri, District Bhiwani.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 6.5.2015 and the co-accused namely Bedpal and Shiv Narain have already been admitted on bail by this Court vide order dated 21.11.2016 passed in CRM-M-34621 of 2016 titled 'Bedpal @ Bedu vs. State of Haryana' and CRM-M-38691 of 2016 titled 'Shiv Narain alias Lala vs. State of Haryana'.

Learned State counsel on instructions from the ASI Rajender Singh does not dispute the custody and the fact that co-accused have been admitted on bail by this Court.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The co-accused Bedpal @ Bedi and Shiv Narain alias Lala have already been admitted on bail by this Court and the petitioner is in custody since 6.5.2016. The trial will take sufficient long time as only challan has been presented and no witness has been examined so far.

Accordingly, the petition is **accepted**. The petitioner is admitted on regular bail on furnishing of his bail bonds and surety bonds subject to satisfaction of the trial Court.

It is made clear that the observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as reflection of any opinion on the merits of the case and the trial Court shall decide the case on the basis of available evidence.
