On 09.12.2015 the following order was passed:-

“It is inter alia argued that on the order Annexure P/4 the petitioners have joined the investigations, however, in the impugned order the same was not taken into consideration by the Court below and it was observed that the petitioners have not cooperated.

Notice of motion for 23.2.2015.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioners be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of arresting/Investigating Officer; that they will join investigation and will abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

As per the allegations, the petitioners had forged the signatures and used fake seal to get a tender.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Chandi Ram states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and because of the problem with their Chartered Accountant the firm has also been blacklisted by the Dakshin Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam.

In this view of the matter I see no reason to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Petition is allowed. Interim order dated 09.12.2015 is made absolute.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
