JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Dilbagh Singh in case FIR No.90 dated 10.08.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 324, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code and subsequently added Section 326 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Ramdass, District Amritsar Rural.

As per allegations the petitioner accused along with other co-accused on 4.8.2015 at around 6 am are alleged to have inflicted injuries on complainant Avtar Singh. Petitioner is alleged to have been armed with a *datar* and inflicted a blow on the head of the complainant Avtar Singh. It is alleged that the injury inflicted by the accused falls under Section 326 IPC.

It is contended that a false case after a delay of six days has been foisted upon the petitioner and his co-accused as a counterblast to an FIR lodged against Avtar Singh on 5.8.2015 for molesting (354-A IPC) the wife of co-accused Kuljinder on 3.8.2015.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 09th of December, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
