JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Present 2nd petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner/accused-Baldev Singh in case FIR No.267 dated 27.09.2014, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 326, IPC added later on), registered with Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

As per the statement of the complainant-Balwinder Singh, while coming from the fields on 21.09.2014, he and his son-Charanjit Singh were attacked by the present petitioner-Baldev Singh and his three other co-accused and injuries inflicted upon both of them.

The petitioner/accused is allegedly armed with a *Sword* and attributed only one injury on the left side of the head of the complainant.

It is contended that the petitioner is in custody since 17.03.2015 and both the injured/material witnesses out of 18 cited prosecution witnesses have since been examined. It is further contended that rest of the co-accused are on bail.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Sulakhan Singh, does not refute the aforesaid factual situation.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period and the facts as noticed above, this Court finds that petitioner/accused deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Disposed of.
