The petitioner has been in custody for the last about 2 years.
Three more witnesses remain to be examined. Co-accused of the petitioner
have been granted concession of bail as they were also not arrested from the
spot.

Taking into consideration period of detention suffered and
adopting the principle of parity, the petitioner is ordered to be released on
bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial
Court subject to the condition that in case the petitioner indulges in similar
activity again during the pendency of the trial, his bail bonds will be liable
to be cancelled.

The petition is allowed.
