marriage and on the merits of the assertions made in the petition, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, to take necessary action on the representation dated 27.11.2016 (Annexure P-5) moved by petitioner No.2 and provide necessary protection to the petitioners in accordance with law, in case he is satisfied that the life and liberty of the petitioners is threatened at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 9.
