Without expressing any opinion with regard to validity of marriage and on the merits of the assertions made in the petition, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to take necessary action on the representation dated

26.11.2016 (Annexure P-8) moved by the petitioners and provide necessary protection to the petitioners in accordance with law in case he is satisfied that the life and liberty of the petitioners is threatened at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 and 5.
