This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members, who are apprehending imminent danger to their lives at the hands of respondent No.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Police Headquarters, Sector-9, Chandigarh to consider and decide the complaint dated 09.03.2016 (Annexure P-2).

At the asking of the Court, Mr. G.S.Chahal, APP, U.T. Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

In the circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Police

Headquarters, Sector-9, Chandigarh is directed to decide the complaint dated 09.03.2016 (Annexure P-2) moved by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order within a period of three weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the order.
