INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner, Amanpreet Singh, has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No64 dated 22.07.2013, registered at Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana, under Sections 302, 364, 201, 148, 149 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner has been declared to be a juvenile by the Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Ludhiana, but at the same time, the petitioner has avoided the process of law and ultimately has been declared proclaimed offender.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I do not find it a fit case

where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.

If the petitioner surrenders before the Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Ludhiana and moves application for bail, the same shall be decided expeditiously.
