This order shall dispose of CRM No. M-41741 of 2015 and CRM No. M-42018 of 2015 as the prayer in both these petitions is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners therein FIR No. 109 dated 08.10.2015, under Sections 379-B, 411 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Division No.1, District Pathankot.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Sushma Kumari wife of Vijay Kumar. Complainant alleged that on 08.10.2015, while coming back from a visit to a doctor, two young boys on a Pulsar motorcycle (black colour) had snatched the purse from her containing Rs.4000/- cash, Aadhar Card, car keys, almirah

keys and a mobile phone.

Petitioners in these two petitions were arrested on 18.10.2015.

Learned State counsel would oppose the grant of regular bail to the petitioners by contending that the petitioners have been duly identified by the complainant. However, no specific response is forthcoming as to on what basis were the present petitioners picked up in the first instance and brought before complainant. It is not even the case made out that due procedure had been followed while conducting identification parade. State counsel would apprise the Court that challan is otherwise ready and would be presented shortly. In other words, investigation in the case is otherwise complete.

In an overview of the matter, petitioners are held entitled to the benefit of bail. Both the petitions are allowed. Petitioners in these two petitions be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Pathankot.
