The petitioner had allegedly committed theft of electric items from the rented premises of complainant Akhil Chadha by making him to consume stupefying material and the food.

Recoveries have already been effected after obtaining police remand of the petitioner. He has been in custody w.e.f. 14.10.2016.

Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner is not involved in any other case and is also a student, he can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, SAS Nagar, Mohali subject to the condition that he will not commit similar offence of which he is accused of, during the entire period of trial.
