I have perused the FIR and also seen the photographs of the cows lying in the container. The petitioner was apprehended on the spot along with 7 cows loaded in an oil tanker which had been converted into a transport carrier so as to conceal the cows loaded therein. The oil tanker did not have the sufficient space nor for respiration to carry such a large number of cows in it. Looking to the conversion of the tanker into a carrier for carrying of cows in order to hide them ; prima facie I find the same to be the utmost cruelty which shows that petitioner has no regard for life though of animals. This shocks the conscience of the Court. The offence committed by the petitioner is heinous, such a person cannot be given the concession of regular bail.

In that view of the matter, the petition is dismissed.
