In FIR No.45 dated 04.03.2016, registered under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act, at Police Station City, Rajpura, District Patiala petitioner was arrested on 18.09.2016 and is in jail since then.

It is clear from the FIR that the petitioner, who was driving the vehicle bearing registration No. PB-08-AL-5868 (Quallis) and no intoxicating substance was recovered from him though the other co-accused is in possession of the intoxicating substance.

In that view of the matter, bail petition is allowed. Petitioner be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence.
