Notice was sent to the petitioner. However, the same was received back with the report that he has since died. From the order of the Trial Court as well as of the Appellate Court we find that the petitioner was convicted under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for one year and to pay fine of ₹ 5,000/-. No compensation was awarded to the complainant. According to us, since the petitioner has died the revision has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.
