This order will dispose of two applications bearing Crl.Misc.Nos.M-41763 of 2015 filed by Rattan Singh and M-41818 of 2015 filed by Jai Chand and Sandeep for grant of regular bail.

The FIR was registered at the instance of Ram Kumar alleging that he, along with Rajender Kumar and nephew Krishan Kumar, were waylaid by 6-7 persons armed with weapons, who arrived on the spot on two separate vehicles. Krishan Kumar was allegedly caught hold of by

Satyawan and Baljit whereas Krishan Kumar was given beatings with a stick. Balsher and Satyanarayan were holding revolvers in their hands. Balsher allegedly had fired a shot on the head of Krishan with his pistol whereas Satyanarayan had struck a pistol on his head as a result of which Krishan fell down and died. Co-accused Charan Siungh had been granted concession of bail as it appeared debatable whether he connived with other accused or shared common intention with others.

Counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the petition on behalf of Rattan Singh with liberty to approach this Court again after some more evidence is produced by the prosecuting agency. So far as Jai Chand and Sandeep are concerned, even if going by the statement of the eye-witnesses, they have not been attributed any specific injury or role except that they pushed eye-witness Rajender while he was making an attempt to catch hold of Rattan Singh.

On the basis of parity with Charan Singh, petition of Jai Chand and Sandeep is allowed. It is ordered that Jai Chand and Sandeep will be released on bail on their furnishing of bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/duty Magistrate.

Application of Rattan Singh is dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
