FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 28.01.2016 of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sohna has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Ms.Nupur Khera and the accused persons namely Rajeev Banga and Akhilesh Mendiratta, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, being a pure matrimonial dispute as the wife has today received four cheques bearing No.011810 and 000141-42-43 worth ₹6,87,500 each (copies

whereof have been placed on the record) as a part fulfillment of the settlement and remaining of which is to be undertaken in the divorce proceedings, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.422 dated 26.05.2014 registered at Police Station Sohna, Gurgaon under Sections 406/420 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
