Petitioner Vinod Kumar has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.148 dated 27.07.2016, registered at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar, under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326 and 452 read with Section 34 IPC.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that earlier, the petitioner was on bail and after adding of Section 326 IPC, he was again

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arrested and has been in judicial custody for the last two months. He also argued that parties have effected compromise.

As per the case of prosecution, grievous injury with *datar* on the head of complainant has been attributed to the present petitioner.

The petitioner is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; in view of the fact that matter has been compromised; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
