Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 438, Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, Ankush Kumar, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 326, 427, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, in a case arising out of FIR No.178, dated 27.10.2015, registered at Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib.

The role attributed to the present petitioner/accused-Ankush Kumar s/o co-accused Satish Kumar is of raising a *lalkara* and having been armed with a *Baseball Bat*.

It is contended that no overt act except *lalkara* has been attributed to the present petitioner.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by H.C. Vakil Singh, concedes that petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required. He further submits that after investigation, cancellation report has been prepared and is awaiting approval.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 10.12.2015, is made absolute/confirmed.
