These are two petitions filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioners arising out of the same FIR bearing No. 162 dated 23.2.2015 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341, 506, 302 and 325 IPC at Police Station Chandani Bagh, District Panipat.

As per the FIR there are allegation against the petitioners that they along with other co-accused caused injuries on the head of the complainant and her family members. The injured were taken to the hospital and on the next day Baru Ram died during treatment due to the

injuries suffered by him.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have undergone custody since 26.2.2015 and similarly situated co-accused namely Rohtash, Vikas and Pawan who were not accused of having inflicted any injury to the accused have been granted regular bail vide order dated 14.9.2015, 19.11.2015 and 26.11.2015 passed in CRM-M No. 30496 of 2015, CRM-M No. 33844 of 2015 and CRM No. 38603 of 2015 (Annexures P-3 to P-5) respectively.

Mr. Satish Saini, DAG., Haryana., on instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar accepted these factual assertions and states that two other persons are also in custody.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the above facts and the period of custody and on the basis of parity, without commenting on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioners on regular bail to the satisfaction of the Trial court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petitions stand allowed.
