This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.52 dated 09.08.2015 under Sections 420 and 380 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Bahadur, District Barnala (Punjab).

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 10.12.2015:-

“Contends that similarly placed co-accused were granted the concession of anticipatory bail. Petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigating agency in every manner.

Notice of motion for 29.01.2016.

Meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join the investigation forthwith. However, in the event of her arrest, she shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/investigating officer, subject to the following conditions:-

- i. She shall make herself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- ii. She shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;*
- iii. She shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.”*

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh, would apprise the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation.

It has also gone uncontroverted that co-accused Babli Kaur has been granted concession of pre-arrest bail by this Court in terms of the order dated 17.11.2015 passed in CRM No. M-31141 of 2015.

Accordingly, petition is allowed. Order dated 10.12.2015, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
