Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Om Parkash in case FIR No.675 dated 30.10.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506 of Indian Penal Code and subsequently added Section 325 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act registered with Police Station Sector 7, Faridabad.

As per the allegations the accused party comprising of 8/9 boys waylaid the complainant party and have inflicted injuries upon Daya Ram and Tek Ram. Petitioner is alleged to be armed with weapon and, therefore, he was also booked under the Arms Act.

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Darshan Lal submits

that there are multiple fractures on the persons of Daya Ram and Tek Ram, therefore, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out to the petitioner. He further submits that after investigation offence of Arms Act has been deleted.

At this stage learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition and seek his remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
