JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 252, dated 21.07.2015 (Annexure P-2), under Sections 408, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 26, Chandigarh along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise dated October 6, 2015 (Annexure P-1).

2. In compliance of order dated December 10, 2015, statement of the parties have been recorded by the trial Court on the payment of Rs.5000/- as costs. Report of learned Additional Chief

Judicial Magistrate, Chandigarh, has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have arrived at compromise without any coercion, threat, inducement or promise from any quarter. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 252, dated 21.07.2015 (Annexure P-2), under Sections 408, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 26, Chandigarh and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioner.
