For having been found in possession of 100 grams of intoxicating powder containing 18 grams of diphenoxylate hydrochloride, the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 21.05.2014.

The petitioner had been granted concession of bail by the Sessions Court but having absented on 21.04.2010, his bail bonds were cancelled. The petitioner has now been in custody for the last eleven months.

The period of detention suffered by the petitioner after having absented, would have a deterrent effect upon the petitioner not to absent from the proceedings.

Without expression of any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
