This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.214 dated 24.08.2015, under Sections 323, 325, 326, 148, 149, 506 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar.

On 16.02.2016, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“During the course of hearing today, it has gone uncontroverted that the injury suffered by the complainant, Inderjit Singh and which has attracted offence under Section 326 IPC is attributed to co-accused Mani and not to the present petitioner.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to

appear before Investigating Officer and to join investigation.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh apprises the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation.

Accordingly, prayer made in the present petition is accepted and petition is allowed.

Order dated 16.02.2016, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
