Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.100 dated 14.08.2013, under Sections 21/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery from the present petitioner is of 350 grams of heroin. During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that co-accused Gurnam Singh @ Gagan and against whom also identical recovery was stated to have been effected has been granted the benefit of regular bail by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide order dated 18.09.2015 in Special Leave to Appeal (Criminal) No.4590 of 2015. The order has been placed on record at Annexure P-4.

On the ground of parity itself, the present petitioner is also held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Tarn Taran.
