The prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.76 dated 23.02.2015, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Kosli, District Rewari.

The petitioner is a Stamp Vendor, who is alleged to have facilitated the execution of an ante-dated agreement to sell dated 26.06.2012, which is a reason for defeating the claim of the complainant for purchase of the same land pursuant to an agreement to sell dated 10.10.2012 in his favour.

It is contended that the petitioner is not the beneficiary. The actual beneficiary-Pooja Devi has since been granted anticipatory bail by this Court, vide order dated 16.07.2015.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Birender Singh, submits that on examination of the register maintained by the petitioner, it has been found that there are many vacant spaces, which are meant to be utilized for ante-dating various deeds. He further submits that to complete the chain of the investigation, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required.

After hearing learned Counsel for the parties, keeping in view the nature of allegations against the petitioner and gravity of the offence, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
