For having been found in possession of 55 grams of intoxicating powder containing Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride which is marginally higher than the commercial quantity prescribed, the petitioner has been arrested on 01.01.2015. He was granted interim bail on 06.06.2015 and again taken into custody on 11.07.2016. It has been informed that only two prosecution witnesses stand examined.

Taking into consideration the quantity of the contraband, this petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that he will not indulge in the similar activity, of which he is accused of, in the present case and he will not tamper with the evidence directly or indirectly.
