Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely Baldev Singh, Basant Singh, Buta Singh, Lakhvir Singh, Gurcharan Singh and Chhinda Singh @ Shupinder Singh in case FIR No.156 dated 20.11.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 336, 506, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act registered with Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda.

The allegations of the complainant Malkiat Singh are that the petitioners armed with deadly weapons including firearms had waylaid him.

Accused Baldev Singh is alleged to have started firing at him.

It is contended that a false case has been foisted on account of

the petitioners-accused having obtained a stay in their favour in the civil dispute pending with the complainant in order to put pressure. It is further submitted that it is case of no injury apart from the fact that petitioners have joined investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by HC Jaswinder Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 10th of December, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
