The petitioner has been in custody with effect from 17.09.2015 in a case of recovery of 500 grams of heroin from the petitioner whereas another 550 grams of heroin was recovered from below the driver seat of the car in which petitioner along with two other co-accused was travelling. Out of total four accused named in the secret information, three including the petitioner were apprehended from the spot whereas the fourth accused was apprehended later on, on the basis of disclosure statement of the petitioner.

The petitioner seeks concession of interim bail solely on the ground that Forensic Science Laboratory report has not been received.

The petition is allowed. The petitioner is granted concession of interim temporary bail till the receipt of report of Forensic Science Laboratory. Petitioner will be released on interim temporary bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that he would be required to surrender after the receipt of FSL report without prejudice to his right to seeks concession of bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C., thereafter.
