Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for directing the official respondents not to harass, humiliate and involve the petitioner in false cases at the behest of private respondents No.6 to 10.

Reply by way of affidavit of Ramneesh Kumar Chaudhary, PPS, ACP (North), Ludhiana has already been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5 wherein it has been stated that the petitioner was never summoned in criminal cases unnecessarily. FIR No.21 dated 27.01.2014 and FIR No.115 dated 20.07.2014 were registered against the

petitioner for the offences committed by him. He has never been harassed or humiliated by the police. It has specifically been denied that he was being called in the police station unnecessarily.

In view of the stand taken by the official respondents in the reply, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and same is accordingly disposed of.
