Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been acquitted in a case under Section 307 IPC by way of compounding compromise by quashing the FIR. Be that as it may Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes that the petitioner would furnish an affidavit before the learned trial Court not to commit any offence in future

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nor he would temper with the evidence of the prosecution, within 4 weeks from today.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed.

Petitioner be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/trial Court concerned.

Petitioner shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence and shall not threaten prosecution witnesses.
