Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 438, Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Sarabjit Kaur, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 177, 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, in a case arising out of FIR No.88, dated 23.10.2015, registered at Police Station Jodhan, Ludhiana (Rural).

As per the allegations, the petitioner/accused-Sarabjit Kaur has forged the documents apart from alleged forged Will of his *Jeth*-Kewal Singh (since deceased) in connivance with other co-accused to pose as the widow of Kewal Singh in order to avail the benefit of pension from the Army and Bank, as also the moveable and immovable property of the deceased-Kewal Singh. The complainants are two daughters of deceased-Kewal Singh.

The petitioner factually is the wife of Lachhman Singh, younger brother of deceased-Kewal Singh.

After arguing for sometime, learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
