This is a petition filed by the petitioner seeking regular bail in FIR No. 118 dated 30.03.2016 registered at Police Station Murthal, Distt. Sonapat under Sections 148, 149, 324, 341, 354, 395, 188, 427 and 435 of IPC.

Counsel for the petitioner states that there is no victim in this case and the police has already submitted a report before the Division Bench that the DNA samples of the persons who were arrested did not match the samples lifted from the clothes found on the spot and Sections 376-D and 365 have been deleted in the supplementary challans that have been filed in the Court below. He also states that no identification parade was conducted and no woman came forward to make a statement against the petitioner. Counsel further states that he had been allowed bail in the other FIR's and the copy of the same are available on record.

The DNA collected by the police did not match with the semen found on the clothes. Section 376-D has been deleted. The police has given a long list of witnesses. The trial would take time.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
