The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to take action against the private respondents, who are accused in case First Information Report No.171 dated 30.10.2016 registered under Sections 323, 341, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Division No.4, Ludhiana and also to direct the official respondents to investigate the matter properly.

On asking of the Court, Mr.CS Brar, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will

be satisfied if respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana is directed to look into the representation (Annexure P5) given by the petitioner.
