This is the petition for transfer of criminal complaint No.128 dated 08.07.2014 titled as Rajinder Singh versus Parshotam Lal, from the court of JMIC, SBS Nagar to some other Court.

Seen the order made by learned Sessions Judge. Learned Sessions Judge find out that there was no satisfactory justification for transferring the case as the reasons given for asking for transfer were not satisfactory.
